Tournament Rules

Please keep a copy of these rules for your use.

Participants must be a USBC member with current membership and in good standing with the USBC.

1. Tournament will consist of three games of 9-Pin No Tap Singles, by the following divisions:

Women: **Div. A**: 50 yrs. to 64 yrs. young, **Div. B**: 65 yrs. and up **Div. A**: 50 yrs. to 64 yrs. young, **Div. B**: 65 yrs. and up

- 2. Bowlers and tournament staff only allowed in bowlers' settee area. All others must remain on the concourse area.
- 3. Tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis of 90% of 230 for men and 90% of 220 for women based on **Rule #4** that follows. All bowlers with an average above 230 for men and 220 for women will bowl scratch.
- 4. Participant's average will be based on the following order for the tournament:
 - a. **Current highest** USBC certified average of 21 or more games as of December 31, 2021 ((bowler must provide a standing sheet for <u>ALL</u> leagues outside of Santa Clara County).
 - b. **2020-21 USBC Composite average** of 21 or more games from bowl.com.
 - c. 2019-20 USBC Composite average of 21 or more games from bowl.com.
 - d. 2018-19 USBC Composite average of 21 or more games from bowl.com.
 - e. If bowler has none of the above averages, bowler will bowl scratch at 230 for men and 220 for women.

Note: It is the participant's responsibility to verify accuracy of his/her average whether originally submitted by participant or others. Submission of a lower or false average could result in disqualification of the participant.

- A substitute bowler will be allowed for paid entries. Substitutes' averages subject to rule 4.
- 6. Entry fee \$32.00 Breakdown: Lineage \$12.00, Expenses \$1.25, Prize fund \$18.75 for \$32.00 total entry fee. **No refunds of entry fees with less than 48-hour notice** prior to 1/28/2022 to the SCCUSBC.
- 7. All prize monies will be returned 100%. Prize ratio will be 1 in every 6 entries per division. Prize monies will be based on total pin fall plus handicap per division. All ties will be combined, and prize money divided evenly.
- 8. Payment of prize monies won will be mailed no later than 30 days after the close of the tournament, except when USBC has authorized delay in payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest which affects tournament standings.
- 9. Tournament squads subject to cancellation due to lack of participation for this event.
- 10. Tournament date: 1/30/22. Pre-registration close: 1/21/22. There are 3 squads: #1: check-in at 9 am and bowl at 10 am; #2: check-in at 11:30 am and bowl at 12:30 pm; and #3: check-in at 2:30 pm and bowl at 3:30 pm. Squad 1 will have only 18 lanes available and Squads 2 & 3 will each have 30 lanes available.
- 11. Multiple participation is allowed at this tournament bowlers will cash with their highest series only.

 Bowlers may pre-register for more than one squad if they choose or walk-in on-site for any squad. Reminder: On-Site entries will be accepted on a first come, first served based on lane availability.
- 12. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RE-RATE ANY ENTRANT PRIOR TO BOWLING. If bowler does not accept re-rate average, entry fee shall be refunded.
- 13. The tournament officials shall have full power to act on any disputes or complaints. Any appeal or protest shall be made in writing within 72 hours per USBC tournament rule 329. Any rules not covered, shall be governed by the 2021-22 USBC tournament rules and regulations.
